Izola Bank p.l.c. First Half 2016 Results - Highlights

Review of Performance

- Profit before tax of €2,111,200 for the six months ended 30 June 2016 up €30,895 or 1 per cent, compared with €2,080,305 for the same period in 2015.
- Operating income of €3,085,917 for the six months ended 30 June 2016, down €14,746 or 0.5 per cent, compared with €3,110,223 for the same period in 2015.
- The Bank's cost-to-income ratio increased to 36 per cent for the six months ended 30 June 2016, an increase of 3 percentage points, compared with 33 per cent for the same period in 2015.
- Loans and advances to customers of €52.7 million at 30 June 2016, down €5.7 million or 10 per cent, compared with 31 December 2015.
- Customer deposits of €110.9 million at 30 June 2016, up €3.6 million, or 3.4 per cent, compared with 31 December 2015.
- Total assets of €177 million at 30 June 2016, up €5.2 million, or 3 per cent, compared with 31 December 2015.
- Earnings per share of €3.54 for the six months ended 30 June 2016 were 5% higher than the earnings per share for the same period in 2015 (€3.38).

Commentary

Izola Bank delivered a profit before tax for the six months ended 30 June 2016 of €2,111,200. This figure remained stable when compared to the same period last year mainly as a result of higher capital gains derived from the Bank's treasury operations and lower provisions against loans.

Due to the prevailing low interest rates and increased deposit taking activity, the Bank experienced a reduction in its net interest income of 8 per cent when compared to the same period last year. For the six months ended 30 June 2016, net interest income was €1,081,433 compared with €1,178,143 at 30 June 2015.

Net fee and commission income of €1,235,225 for the six months ended 30 June 2016 decreased by €140,755, or 10 per cent, compared with 30 June 2015. This was due to a reduction in factoring activity experienced during the first six months of the year.

Administrative expenses increased by 30% compared to the same period last year and this resulted in an increase in the Bank's cost-to-income ratio of 3 percentage points from 33 per cent for the period ended 30 June 2015 to 36 per cent for the period ended 30 June 2016.

During the first six months of 2016 the bank reduced its loans and advances to customers by €5.7 million, or 10 per cent and its investments were increased by €5.1 million, or 9.8 per cent, compared with 31 December 2015. The quality of the lending portfolio showed no sign of deterioration whilst liquidity and capital ratios remained substantially above regulatory requirements.

Basis of preparation

The condensed interim financial statements have been extracted from Izola Bank p.l.c.'s (the 'bank') unaudited management accounts for the six months period ended 30 June 2016. These condensed interim financial statements are being published in terms of Chapter 5 of the Listing Rules issued by the Listing Authority and in terms of the Prevention of Financial Markets Abuse Act, 2005.

The condensed interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting standards adopted for use in the EU for interim financial statements (adopted IAS 34, Interim Financial Reporting). They do not include all of the information required for full annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2015.

The accounting policies applied in these condensed interim financial statements are the same as those applied by the bank in its financial statements as at, and for the year ended, 31 December 2015.

As required by the adopted IAS 34, Interim Financial Reporting, these interim financial statements include comparative statements of financial position information at the previous financial year end and comparative income statements information for the comparable interim periods of the immediately preceding financial year.
