Izola Bank p.l.c. First Half 2013 Results - Highlights

Review of Performance

- Profit before tax of €1,239,191 for the six months ended 30 June 2013 down €21,188 or 1.7 per cent, compared with €1,260,379 for the same period in 2012.
- Operating income of €2,043,535 for the six months ended 30 June 2013, up €183,379 or 9.9 per cent, compared with €1,860,156 for the same period in 2012.
- The Bank's cost-to-income ratio increased to 39.4 per cent for the six months ended 30 June 2013, up 7.2 per cent, compared with 32.2 per cent for the same period in 2012.
- Loans and advances to customers of €21 million at 30 June 2013, up €2 million or 9.9 per cent, compared with 31 December 2012.
- Customer deposits of €57 million at 30 June 2013, up €2.5 million, or 4.5 per cent, compared with 31 December 2012.
- Total assets of €100 million at 30 June 2013, up €5 million, or 5.3 per cent, compared with 31 December 2012.
- Earnings per share of €2.02 for the six months ended 30 June 2013 were in line with the earnings per share for the same period in 2012.

Commentary

Izola Bank delivered a profit before tax for the six months ended 30 June 2013 of €1,239,191. This figure was slightly lower than the same period last year due to low prevailing market rates.

In fact net interest income of €848,345 for the six months ended 30 June 2013 was down €115,855 or 12.0 per cent, compared with 30 June 2012.

Net fee and commission income of €966,329 for the six months ended 30 June 2013, increased by €87,761 or 10.0 per cent, compared with 30 June 2012. This was mainly due to an expanded factoring portfolio.

The increase in the Bank's cost-to-income ratio by 7.2 per cent to 39.4 per cent was due to an increase in administration expenses and impairment allowances.

During the first six months of 2013 the bank grew its loans and advances to customers by €2 million, or 9.9 per cent, compared with 31 December 2012. The quality of the lending portfolio showed no sign of deterioration whilst liquidity and capital ratios remained substantially above regulatory requirements.

Basis of preparation

The condensed interim financial statements have been extracted from Izola Bank p.l.c.'s (the 'bank') unaudited management accounts for the six months period ended 30 June 2013. These condensed interim financial statements are being published in terms of Chapter 5 of the Listing Rules issued by the Listing Authority and in terms of the Prevention of Financial Markets Abuse Act, 2005.

The condensed interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting standards adopted for use in the EU for interim financial statements (adopted IAS 34, Interim Financial Reporting). They do not include all of the information required for full annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012.

The accounting policies applied in these condensed interim financial statements are the same as those applied by the bank in its financial statements as at, and for the year ended, 31 December 2012.

As required by the adopted IAS 34, Interim Financial Reporting, these interim financial statements include comparative statements of financial position information at the previous financial year end and comparative income statements information for the comparable interim periods of the immediately preceding financial year.
